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

# (Chapter II .- Dental Council of India.)

Provided that not more than one member shall be elected from the kame denial college;

Provided that pending the preparation of registers the [State] Governments may nominate to the first Council members referred to in parts (a) and (e) and the Central Government members referred to in part (f) out of persons who are eligible for registration in the respective registers and such persons shall hold office for such period as the '[State] or Central Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, specify.

- 4. The Council shall be a body corporate by the name of the Dental Coun-incorporation of cil of India, having perpetual succession and a common seal, with power to Council. acquire and hold property, both movable and immovable, and shall by the said name sue and be sued.
- 5. Elections under this Chapter shall be conducted in the prescribed Mode of election manner, and where any dispute arises regarding any such election, it shall be referred to the Central Government whose decision shall be final.
- 6. (1) Subject to the provisions of this section an elected or nominated Term of office member shall hold office for a term of five years from the date of his election and casual or nomination or until his successor has been duly elected or nominated, which-

- (2) An elected or nominated member may at any time resign his membership by writing under his hand addressed to the President, and the seat of such member shall thereupon become vacant.
- (3) An elected or nominated member shall be deemed to have vacated his seat if he is absent without excuse, sufficient in the opinion of the Council, from three consecutive ordinary meetings of the Council or, in the case of a member whose name is required to be included in a '[State] register, if his name is removed from such register, or if he has been elected under clause (c) of section 3, '[if he ceases to hold his appointment as the '[Principal, Dean, Director or Vice-Principal] of a dental college, or as '[the Head of the dental wing] of a medical college], or if he has been elected under clause (b) or (d) of section 3, if he ceases to be a member of the Medical Council of India or '[the Dental or Medical Faculty] of the University, as the case may be.
- (4) A casual vacancy in the Council shall be filled by fresh election or nomination, as the case may be, and the person elected or nominated to fill the vacancy shall hold office only for the remainder of the term for which the member whose place he takes was elected or nominated.
- . (5) Members of the Council shall be eligible for re-election or re-nomi-
- (6) No act done by the Council shall be called in question on the ground merely of the existence of any vacancy in, or defect in the constitution of, the Council.

President and Vice-President of Council.

7. (1) The President and Vice-President of the Council shall be elected by the members thereof from among themselves:

Provided that on the first constitution of the Council and until the President is elected, a member of the Council nominated by the Central Government in this behalf shall discharge the functions of the President:

Provided further that for five years from the first constitution of the Council, the President shall, if the Central Government so decides, be a person nominated by the Central Government who shall hold office during the pleasure of the Central Government, and where he is not already a member, shall be a member of the Council in addition to the members referred to in section 3.

(2) An elected President or Vice-President shall hold office as such for a term not exceeding five years and not extending beyond the expiry of his term as member of the Council, but subject to his being a member of the Council, he shall be eligible for re-election.

Staff, remuneration and allowances.

#### 8. (1) The Council shall-

- (a) appoint a Secretary who may also, if so decided by the Council, act as Treasurer:
- (b) appoint such other officers and servants as the Council deems necessary to enable it to carry out its functions under this Act;

- (e) require and take from the Secretary or from any other officer or servant such security for the due performance of his duties as the Council considers necessary; and
- (d) with the previous sanction of the Central Government, fix the fees and allowances of the President, Vice-President and other members of the Council, and the pay and allowances and other conditions of service of officers and servants of the Council.
- (2) Notwithstanding anything contained in clause (a) of sub-section (1), for the first four years from the first constitution of the Council, the Secretary of the Council shall be a person appointed by the Central Government, who shall hold office during the pleasure of the Central Government.
- 9. (1) The Council shall constitute from among its members an Executive tive Committee, and may so constitute other Committees for such general Committee. or special purposes as the Council considers necessary for carrying out its functions under this Act.
- (2) The Executive Committee shall consist of the President and Vice-President ex officio 'and the Director-General of Health Services ex officio], and five other members elected by the Council,
- (3) The President and Vice-President of the Council shall be Chairman and Vice-Chairman, respectively, of the Executive Committee.
- (4) A member of the Executive Committee shall hold office as such until the expiry of his term of office as member of the Council but, subject to his being a member of the Council, he shall be eligible for re-election.
- (5) In addition to the powers and duties conferred and imposed on it by this Act, the Executive Committee shall exercise and discharge such powers and duties as may be prescribed.

- (2) Any authority or institution in India which grants a dental qualification not included in Part I of the Schedule may apply to the Central Government to have such qualification recognised and included in that Part, and the Central Government, after consulting the Council, and after such inquiry, if any, as it may think fit for the purpose, may, by notification in the : Official Gazette, amend Part I of the Schedule so as to include such qualification therein, and any such notification may also direct that an entry shall be made in Part I of the Schedule against such dental qualification declaring that it shall be a reenguised clental qualification only when granted after a specified date.
- (3) (a) The dental qualifications, granted by any authority or institution. outside India, which are included in Part II of the Schedule shall be recognised dental qualifications only for the purposes of the registration of citizens of India when the register is first prepared under this Act.

- (5) The Council may enter into negotiations with any authority or institution in any State or country outside India which, by law of any such State or country, is entrusted with the maintenance of a register of dentists, for the settling of a scheme of reciprocity for the recognition of dental qualifications and in pursuance of any such scheme; the Central Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, declare that any such qualification granted by any authoraly or institution in any such State or country, or such qualification, only when granted after a specified date, shall be a recognised dental qualisication for the purposes of this Act, and any such notification may provide for . an amendment of the Schedule and may also direct that any such dental qualification as is specified in the notification shall be entered in the Schedule as so amended.
- (6) The Central Government may, after consultation with the Council, by notification in the Official Gazette, amend the Schedule by directing that an entry be made therein in respect of any dental qualification declaring that it shall be a recognised dental qualification only when granted before a specified date.]

Dwillications of dental bygienists.

Any authority in a "[State] " " which grants a qualification for dental hygienists may apply to the Council to have such qualification recognised. and the Council may, after such inquiry, if any, as it thinks fit, and after consulting the Government and the [State] Council of the [State] in which the authority making the application is situated, declare that such qualification, or such qualification only when granted after a specified date, shall be a recognised. dental hygiene qualification for the purposes of this Act.

12. The Council may, prescribe the period and nature of an apprenticeship dental mechanics. or training which shall be undergone and the other conditions which shall be satisfied by a person before he is entitled to be registered under this Act as a dental mechanic.

Power to make regulations.

- 20. (1) The Council may, with the approval of the Central Government, '[by notification in the Official Gazette,] make regulations not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act o carry out the purposes of this Chapter.
- (2) In particular and without projudice to the generality of the foregoing power such regulations may-
  - (a) provide for the management of the property of the Council
  - (b) prescribe the manner in which elections under this Chapter shall be conducted:
  - (c) provide for the summoning and holding of meetings of the Council and the Executive Committee, the times and places at which such meetings shall be held, the conduct of business thereat and the number of members necessary to constitute a quorum;
    - (d) prescribe the functions of the Executive Committee;
    - (e) prescribe the powers and duties of the President and Vice-President;
  - (f) prescribe the tenure of office and the powers and duties of the Secretary [and other officers and servants of the Council, and Inspectors, and Visitors appointed by the Council);
  - (g) prescribe the standard curricula for the training of dentists and dental hygienists, and the conditions for admission to courses of such train-
  - (ii) prescribe the standards of examinations and other requirements to be satisfied to secure for qualifications recognition under this Act;
  - (1) any other matter which is to be or may be prescribed under this Act:

Provided that regulations under clauses (g) and (h) shall be made after consultation with [State] Governments.

- (3) To enable the Council to be first constituted, the Central Government may make regulations for the conduct of the elections to the Council, and any regulation so made may be altered or rescinded by the Council in exercise of its.
- [(4) Every regulation made under this section shall be laid, as soon as may be after it is made, before each House of Parliament, while it is in session, for a total period of thirty days which may be comprised in one session or in two or more successive sessions, and if, before the expiry of the session immediately. following the session or the successive sessions aforesaid, both House agree in making any modifications in the regulation or both Houses agree that the regulation should not be made, the regulation shall thereafter have effect only in such modified form or be of no effect, as the case may be; so, however, that any such modification or annulment shall be without prejudice to the validity of anything previously done under that regulation.]...

#### . 'ISTATE DENTAL COUNCILS

- 21. Except where a Joint '[State] Council is constituted in accordance with Constitution and an agreement made under section 22, the '[State] Government shall constitute a State Councils. '[State] Council consisting of the following members, namely:-
  - (a) four members elected from among themselves by dentists registered in Part A of the '[State] register:

- (5) A copy of the accounts of the Council as so certified together with the audit report thereon shall be forwarded simultaneously to the Council.]

- (5) Whenever it appears to the '[State] Government that the '[State] Council is not complying with any of the provisions of this Act, the '[State] Government may likewise appoint a similar Commission of Enquiry in respect of the '[State] Council to make enquiry in like manner and pass such order or take such action as specified in sub-sections (3) and (4).

    - (f) the forms of certificates of registration and renewal;]

#### DENTAL COUNCIL OF INDIA NOTIFICATION New Delhi

No. DCI - In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 20 of the Dentists Act, 1948 (16 of 1948), the Dental Council of India, with the previous sanction of the Central Government hereby makes the following regulations, namely:

- Short title and commencement (1) These regulations may be called the Screening Test Regulations, 2002
  - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- Definitions:- In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires,
  - a) "Act" means the Dentists Act, 1948 (16 of 1948);
  - b) "Council" means the Denial Council of India constituted under section 3 of the Act;
  - c) "Permanent Registration" means registration for the purpose of enrolment on any State Dental register or Indian Dental Register after obtaining the Primary Dental qualification followed by completion of such practical training as prescribed either in India or abroad as per the provisions of the Act:
  - d) "Prescribed" means prescribed by regulations made under this Act:
  - "Prescribed Authority" means a Dental institution or any other examining body authorised by the Central Government/Dental Council of India to conduct Screening Text.
  - f) "Primary Dental qualification": means a dental qualification awarded by any Dental institution outside India which is a recognized qualification for enrolment as dental practitioner in the country in which the institution awarding the said qualification is situated and which is equivalent to BDS in India:
  - g) "Provisional Registration" means provisional registration in a State Dental Register or Indian Dental Register for the purpose of undergoing practical training in India as prescribed and for no other purpose by an Indian citizen possessing any primary dental qualification but has not undergone such practical training after obtaining that qualification as may be required by the rules or regulations in force in the country granting the qualification;
  - become eligible for admission to BDS Course in India as prescribed in the BDS Course Regulations, 2001.
  - i) "registration" means either Provisional Registration or Permanent Registration.
  - An Indian citizen possessing a primary dental qualification awarded by any dental institution outside India who is desirous of getting provisional or permanent registration with the Dental Council of India or any State Dental Council on or after \_\_\_\_\_\_ shall have to qualify a screening test conducted by the prescribed authority for that purpose as per the provisions of section 13 of the Act:

Provided that a person seeking permanent registration shall not have to quality the screening test if he/she had already qualified the same before getting his/her provisional registration.



- 4. Eligibility Criteria: no person shall be allowed to appear in the screening test unless:
  - (1) he/she is a citizen of India and possesses any primary dental qualification, ether whose name and the institution awarding it are included in the World Directory of Dental Schools, published by the World Health Organisation; or which is confirmed by the Indian embassy concerned to be a recognised qualification for enrolment as dental practitioner in the country in which the institution awarding the said qualification is situated;
  - (2) he/she obtained 'Eligibility Certificate' from the Dental Council of India as per the 'Eligibility Requirement for taking admission in an undergraduate medical course in a Foreign Medical Institution Regulations, 2002'. This requirement shall not be necessary in respect of Indian citizens who have acquired the dental qualifications from foreign dental institutions or have obtained admission in foreign dental institution before
- The purpose of conducting the screening test shall be only to determine the eligibility or otherwise of a candidate for his or her registration with the Dental Council of India or any State Dental Council and qualifying the same shall not confer any other right, whomsoever, on a candidate.
- 6. The details regarding the Scheme for conducting the screening test and the syllabus of the test shall be announced by the Dental Council of India from time to time for the information of the candidates.
- 7. The screening test shall be conducted twice every year as per the Schedule of examination announced by the Prescribed Authority. The procedure of conducting the test shall be in accordance with the Scheme announced by the Dental Council of India in this regard.
- 8. There shall be three papers of multiple choice questions in Pre-Clinical, Para-Clinical and Clinical Medicine and its allied subjects including Obstetrics and Gynaecology. The language of the test shall be English. The test for each paper shall be of three hours duration.
- 9. A candidate shall be declared as having passed only if he/she obtains a minimum of 50% (fifty percent) marks in each paper separately. The minimum qualifying marks shall apply to all categories of candidates without exception.
- A candidate may avail of maximum three chances to appear and pass the test. Actual appearance at the test will constitute an attempt. If he/she does not qualify even in his/her 3<sup>rd</sup> appearance in the test, the candidate will not be eligible for registration by any State Dental Council.
- The prescribed Authority shall intimate the result of the Screening Test to the candidates as well as to the Secretary. Dental Council of India and the State Dental Councils. The unsuccessful candidates shall also be appropriately informed. The candidates who qualify the Screening Test may apply to any State Dental Council for provisional registration/permanent registration alongwith the requisite registration fee in favour of the State Dental Council. The State Dental Councils shall issue registration to such successful candidates, who are yet to undergo one year internship in an approved institution and issue permanent registration to such eligible candidates who have already undergone one year internship, as the case may be.

The following Act of Parliament received the assent of the President on the 2nd April 1993, and is hereby published for general information:—

# THE DENTISTS (AMENDMENT) ACI, 1993

[2nd April, 1993.]

An Act further to amend the Dentists Act 1948.

Be it enacted by Parliament in the Forty-fourth Year of the Republic of India as follows.—

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993.
- (2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 27th day of August, 1992.

2. After section 10 of the Dentials Act, 1948 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), the following sections shall be inserted, namely:—

Short tide and commencement

Insertion of new sections 10A, 10B

10A. (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or any

(a) no person shall establish an authority or institution for a course of study or training (including a post-graduate course of study or training) which would enable a student of such course or training to qualify himself for the grant of recognised dental qualification; or

(ii) increase its admission capacity in any course of study or training (including a post-graduate course of study

except with the previous permission of the Central Government obtained in accordance with the previsions of this section.

Explanation 1.—For the purposes of this section, "person" includes any University or a trust but does not include the Central

Explanation 2.—For the purposes of this section, "admission capacity", in relation to any course of study or training (including a post-graduate course of study or training) in an authority institution granting recognised dental qualification, means the maximum number of students that may be fixed by the Council from time to time for being admitted to such course or training.

- (2) (a) Every person, authority or institution granting recognised dental qualification shall, for the purpose of obtaining permission under sub-section (1), submit to the Central Government a scheme in accordance with the provisions of clause (h) and the Central Government shall refer the said scheme to the Council for its re-
- (b) The scheme referred to in clause (a) shall be in such form and contain such particulars and be preferred in such manner and be accompanied with such fee as may be prescribed.
- (3) On receipt of a scheme by the Council under sub-section (2), the Council may obtain such other particulars as may be considered necessary by it from the person, authority or institution concerned, granting recognised dental qualification and thereafter. it
  - (a) if the scheme is defective and does not contain any necessary particulars, give a reasonable opportunity to person, authority or institution concerned for making a written representation and it shall be open to such person, authority or institution to rectify the defects, if any, specified by the
  - (b) consider the scheme, having regard to the factors referred to in sub-section (7), and submit the scheme together with its recommendations thereon to the Central Government.

(4) The Central Government may, after considering the scheme and the recommendations of the Council under sub-section (3) and after obtaining, where necessary, such other particulars as may be considered necessary by it from the person, authority or institution concerned, and having regard to the factors referred to in sub-section. (7), either approve (with such conditions, if any, as it may consider necessary) or disapprove the scheme and any such approval shall be a permission under sub-section (1):

Provided that no scheme shall be disapproved by the Central Government except after giving the person, authority or institution concerned granting recognised denial qualification a reasonable opportunity of being heard:

Provided further that nothing in this sub-section shall prevent any person, authority or institution whose scheme has not been approved to submit a fresh scheme and the provisions of this section shall apply to such scheme, as if such scheme has been submitted for the first time under sub-section (2).

- (5) Where within a period of one year from the date of submission of the scheme to the Central Government under sub-section (2), no order passed by the Central Government has been communicated to the person, authority or institution submitting the scheme, such scheme shall be deemed to have been approved by the Central Government in the form in which it had been submitted, and, accordingly, the permission of the Central Government required under sub-section (1) shall also be deemed to have been granted.
- (6) In computing the time-limit specified in sub-section (5), the time taken by the person, authority or institution concerned submitting the scheme in furnishing any particulars called for by the Council or by the Central Government, shall be excluded.
- (7) The Council, while making its recommendations under clause (b) of sub-section (3) and the Central Government, while passing an order either approving or disapproving the scheme under subsection (4), shall have due regard to the following factors, namely:—
  - (a) whether the proposed authority or institution for grant of recognised dental qualification or the existing authority or institution seeking to open a new or higher course of study or training, would be in a position to offer the minimum standards of dental education in conformity with the requirements referred to in section 16A and the regulations made under sub-section (1) of section 20;
  - (b) whether the person seeking to establish an authority or institution or the existing authority or institution seeking to open a new or higher course of study or training or to increase its admission capacity has adequate resources;
  - (c) whether necessary facilities in respect of staff, equipment, accommodation, training and other facilities to ensure

proper functioning of the authority or institution or conducting [PART II\_ the new course of study or training or accommodating the increased admission capacity have been provided or would provided within the time-limit specified in the scheme;

- (d) whether adequate hospital facilities, having regard the number of students likely to attend such authority or institution or course of study or training or as a result of the increased admission capacity have been provided or would be provided within the time-limit specified in the scheme;
- (e) whether any arrangement has been made or programme drawn to impart proper training to students likely to attend such authority or institution or course of study or training by persons having the recognised dental qualifications;
- (f) the requirement of manpower in the field of practice of dentistry; and
  - (g) any other factors as may be prescribed.
- (8) Where the Central Government passes an order either ap. proving or disapproving a scheme under this section, a copy of the order shall be communicated to the person, authority or institution
- 10B. (1) Where any authority or institution is established grant of recognised dontal qualification except with the previous permission of the Central Government in accordance with provisions of section 10A, no dental qualification granted to any student of such authority or institution shall be a recognised dental qualification for the purposes of this Act.
- (2) Where any authority or institution dental qualification opens a new or higher course of study or training fincluding a post-graduate entirse of study or training) except with the previous permission of the Central Government in accordance with the provisions of section 10A, no dental qualification granted to any student of such authority or institution on the basis of such study or training shall be a recognised dental qualification for the
- (3) Where any authority or institution granting recognised dentat qualification increases its admission capacity in any study or training (including a post-graduate course of study training) except with the previous permission of the Central Government in accordance with the provisions of section 10A, no dental qualification granted to any student of such authority or institution on the basis of the increase in its admission capacity shall be a recognised dental qualification for the purposes of this Act.

Explanation.—For the purposes of this section, the criteria for Identifying a student who has been granted a dental qualification on the hasis of such increase in the admission capacity shall be such as

(1) If, after the 1st day of June, 1992 and on and before the commencement of the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993 any person has established an authority or institution for grant of recognised dental qualification or any authority or institution granting recognised dental qualification has opened a new or higher course of study or training (including a post-graduate course of study or training) or increased its admission capacity, such person, authority or institution, as the case may be, shall seek, within a period of one year from the commencement of the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993, the permission of the Central Government in accordance with the provisions of section 10A.

- (2) If any person or, as the case may be, any authority or institution granting recognised dental qualification fails to seek the permission under sub-section (1), the provisions of section 10B shall apply, so far as may be, as if permission of the Central Government under section 10A has been refused.
- 3. In section 20 of the principal Act, in sub-section (2), after clause (f), the following clauses shall be inserted, namely:—
